India Makes it to Top 100 in 'ease of doing business': World Bank

- i. India broke into the top 100 in the World Bank's Ease of Doing Business rankings, notching up the biggest improvement among all countries on the back of big gains on a number of measures.
- ii. The rise to the 100th position from 130 last year made India one of the top 10 best-improved countries and rounded off a day of good news on the economic front for the government. The World Bank's 'Doing Business 2018 Reforming to Create Jobs' report ranks 190 countries on the basis of a combined score on 10 parameters.

India Tops List of New Tuberculosis Cases in 2016: WHO

- **i. India topped the list of seven countries,** accounting for 64 percent of the 10.4 million new tuberculosis (TB) cases worldwide in 2016, according to a new report by the World Health Organisation.
- **ii.** India was followed by Indonesia, China, Philippines, Pakistan, Nigeria and South Africa, according to a **Global TB Report 2017** released by the WHO. An estimated 1.7 million people died from TB in 2016. Also, India along with China and the Russia accounted for almost of half of the 490,000, Multidrug-Resistant TB (MDR-TB) cases registered in 2016.

- i. The government set up a ministerial panel, led by finance minister Arun Jaitley, to consider and oversee mergers among the country's 21 state-run banks.
- ii. Members of the panel on PSU bank consolidation include railway and coal minister Piyush Goyal, and defence minister Nirmala Sitharaman.

- i. Chairman of Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) Mukesh Ambani overtook China's Hui Ka Yan to become Asia's richest person with a total wealth of \$42.1 billion, according to Forbes' real-time billionaire's list.
- ii. Ambani's personal wealth rose by \$466 million. On the other hand, the wealth of China Evergrande Group's Chairman Hui Ka Yan slumped by \$1.28 billion to \$40.6 billion. Globally, **Ambani stood at the 14th spot on Forbes' real-time billionaire's list**, which is based on the value of person's stock holding and assets on a real-time basis

Maximum Age of Joining NPS Increased from 60 to 65 years: Finance Ministry

i. The Ministry of Finance increased the maximum age of joining the National Pension System (NPS) from the

existing 60 years to 65 years under NPS - Private Sector (i.e. all citizen and corporate model).

ii. In accordance with several initiatives undertaken by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) during the last few years, now any Indian citizen, resident or non-resident, between the age of 60 - 65 years, can join NPS and continue up to the age of 70 years.

Gender Vulnerability Index: Goa Safest, Bihar Least Safe

i. Goa is safest for girls, and Bihar least safe, according to a newly-formed Gender Vulnerability Index (GVI) by NGO Plan India. National Capital Delhi ranks only better than Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. ii. The GVI attempts to "generate a normative consensus" on the status of girls and women in India and takes into account four core dimensions: Education, health and survival, poverty, protection.

India Slips 21 Slots on WEF Gender Gap index

- **i.** India slipped 21 places on the World Economic Forum's Global Gender Gap index to 108, behind neighbours China and Bangladesh, primarily due to less participation of women in the economy and low wages, according to the WEF Global Gender Gap Report 2017.
- **ii.** India's latest ranking is 10 notches lower than its reading in 2006 when the WEF started measuring the gender gap. According to the Report, India has closed 67 percent of its gender gap. Bangladesh ranked 47th while China was placed at 100th.

Maharashtra Govt Adds 18m to Shivaji statue, to be World's Tallest at 210m

- i. The 210-metre-high statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj has received environmental clearance, making it the world's tallest statue, once built.
- **ii.** The Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority (MCZMA) approved the government's application to increase the height from the earlier proposed 192 metres. Currently, the Spring Temple Buddha statue, which stands at 208 metres in China, is the world's tallest statue.

i. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the most anticipated International Mega Food event- World Food India 2017, the biggest congregation of global investors and business leaders of major food companies.

ii. The event is organised by the **Food Processing Industries Ministry in Delhi.** The three-day event aims to transform food economy and realise the vision of doubling of farmers' income by establishing India as a preferred investment destination.

The amount of Scholarship will be Rs. 6000/- per annum @ Rs. 500/- per month.

- i. Tata Steel has established India's largest Coke Dry Quenching (CDQ) facility, capable of handling 200 metric tonnes per hour, at its state-of-the-art steel plant at Kalinganagar Industrial Complex in Jajpur district of Odisha.
- **ii.** CDQ is a heat recovery system to cool hot coke from coke ovens. It is one of the best energy-efficient and environment-friendly facility in steel production where hot coke removed from coke ovens at a temperature of around 1,000 degree Celsius is cooled and kept dry with the inert gas.

India becomes Second Largest Fish Producing Country in the World

- **i.** Combining the production of all types of fisheries (capture and culture), the total fish production has reached at about 11.41 million tonnes in 2016-17 and India has become the second largest fish producing country in the world, Union Agriculture Minister Radhan Mohan Singh stated while addressing a conference on the occasion of World Fisheries Day in New Delhi.
- **ii.** The scheme 'Blue Revolution' has been launched with the outlay of Rs. 300 crore for the integrated development of the Fisheries sector in the country. As a result, overall fish production has registered an increase of about 18.86% in comparison to the last three years, whereas inland fish production has registered a growth of more than 26%.

Bamboo not a 'tree' any more: President Clears Ordinance Amending Forest Act

- **i.** President Ram Nath Kovind has cleared an ordinance amending the Indian Forest Act, 1927. The ordinance omits bamboo grown in non-forest areas from the definition of trees, thereby exempting it from requiring permits for felling or transportation.
- **ii.** Before the ordinance was issued, the definition of tree in the Act included palm, bamboo, brushwood and cane. Bamboo grown in forest areas shall continue to be governed by the Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

India urges UN to declare 2018 as 'International Year of Millets'

- **i.** Union Agriculture Minister Radha Mohan Singh has sent a proposal to United Nations for declaring 2018 as "International Year of Millets" to raise awareness among consumers, policy makers, industry and research sector.
- **ii.** Promotion of production and consumption of millets through conscious efforts at global level is likely to contribute substantially in the fight against targeted hunger and mitigate the effect of climate change in long run.



- i. Michael Jackson is atop the Forbes list of top-earning dead celebrities for the fifth straight year, with \$75 million (all figures in US).
- ii. Golf legend Arnold Palmer claims the No. 2 spot with \$40 million and Peanuts creator Charles Schulz ranks third with the income of \$38 million. The list is compiled from information gathered from pretax income from Oct. 15, 2016, through Oct. 15, 2017 before deducting cuts for agents, managers, and lawyers.

Fake News' Named Word of the Year 2017

- **i. Fake news,** a term popularised by U.S. President Donald Trump, **has been named the word of the year by Collins dictionary** due to its widespread use around the world.
- ii. The U.K.-based lexicographer found that the use of "fake news" registered a 365% rise in the last 12months. 'Fake news' takes over from Brexit which was named the definitive word last year.

World's Third Largest Book Fair Opens in Sharjah

i. With more than 1.5 million book titles and 1,650 publishing houses from 60 countries, **Sharjah International Book Fair** (**SIBF**) opened its doors to public and trade visitors. It is the third largest book fair in the world. ii. The book fair was held under the theme 'A World in My Book'. The event has been organised by **Sharjah Book Authority** (**SBA**). **Sharjah** also inaugurated **Sharjah Publishing City** (**SPC**) which is the **world's first specialised book publishing free zone**.

- ii. 714 Indians reportedly appear in the tally. Further, the Government has directed that investigations in cases of Paradise Papers will be monitored through a reconstituted Multi Agency Group, headed by the Chairman, CBDT Sushil Chandra.

Guinea Becomes New Member Of International Solar Alliance

- i. External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj held a meeting with Guinea's Foreign Minister, Mamady Toure, during the course of which the latter handed over his country's instrument accession to the India-initiated International Solar Alliance (ISA).
- **ii.** According to a statement issued by the External Affairs Ministry, Sushma Swaraj and Toure exchanged views on a broad range of subjects covering bilateral friendship and cooperation.

- **i. China has launched world's first all-electric ship** that can travel up to 80 km with 2000-tonnes cargo after a two-hour charge.
- **ii.** The 70.5-metre-long ship, which weighs about 600 tonnes, was launched in Guangzhou in South China's Guangdong Province. The vessel, manufactured by the Guangzhou Shipyard International Company Ltd, is powered by a 26-tonne lithium battery.
- iii. It can cruise at the top speed of 12.8 km per hour.

Syria Signs up Paris Agreement on Climate Change

i. According to the UN report, **Syria has officially signed up to the Paris Agreement,** leaving the United States as the only country to reject the global climate-rescue pact.

ii. Syria became the 169th of 196 countries that are members of the UN climate convention to take the legal step of ratification. After Nicaragua signed up in October 2017, Syria and USA were the only countries not to have adopted the pact.

The Finnish driver comfortably secured the third win of his F1 career, all this season since joining from Williams. It was his 22nd career podium and 13th with Mercedes. Third spot in Abu Dhabi Grand Prix was occupied by Ferrari's

Sebastian Vettel. This race took place at Yas Marina Cicuit in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (UAE).

India claim 5 gold medal, become champions at World Youth Boxing

i. India won 5 gold medals at the AIBA World Women's Youth Boxing Championships, in Guwahati. **ii.** Nitu (48kg), Jyoti Gulia (51kg), Sakshi choudhury (54kg), Shashi Chopra (57kg) and Ankushita Boro (64kg) won gold medals for India in the finals. Jyoti Gulia also qualified for next year's Youth Olympic Games in Argentina. Ankushita was named the boxer of the tournament.

Olympics: IOC bans Five more Russians for life over Sochi Doping

- **i.** Five more Russian competitors from the 2014 Sochi Winter Olympics, including two gold medallists, have been banned for life over anti-doping rule violations by International Olympic Committee (IOC).
- **ii.** Dmitrii Trunenkov and Aleksei Negodailo, both in the gold-medal winning four-man bobsleigh team, plus biathlon relay silver medalists Yana Romanova and Olga Vilukhina, who also won silver in the 7.5 kilometers event. Sergei Chudinov, who came fifth in the men's individual skeleton, was also disqualified for doping breaches.

ii. Olympic bronze medalist Karnam Malleshwari had won the top prize in worlds twice- in 1994 and 1995. Some of the world's top weightlifting nations such as Russia, China, Kazakhstan, Ukraine and Azerbaijan could not take part in the competition due to issues related to doping.

Odisha CM Unveils Logo & Mascot of Hockey World Cup 2018

- **i.** Logo and mascot of Hockey World Cup 2018 have been unveiled at Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar by Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik. Odisha had successfully hosted the Asian Athletics Championships recently.
- **ii.** As many as 16 countries, including hosts India, will participate in the 14th edition of the Hockey World Cup. The Chief Minister also launched the countdown timer for the international event scheduled to be held in Bhubaneshwar next year.


