National

Mughalsarai Junction Renamed As Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Junction

- i. The iconic Mughalsarai Railway Junction in Uttar Pradesh has been renamed as Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Junction Railway station. BJP National President Amit Shah inaugurated the renamed station. A goods train with an all-woman crew was also flagged off.
- **ii.** A smart yard project was also launched on the occasion. The bi-weekly Ekatmata Express, train connecting Lucknow and Deen Dayal Upadhyay Junction was also flagged off.

GST Council Announces Cashback For Digital Transactions

- i. In the 29th meeting, GST council approves cash incentives to promote Digital transactions. Finance Minister Piyush Goyal announces 20% Cashback upto Rs 100 for the Digital Transactions done via BHIM, Rupay or USSD mode.
- **ii.** The meeting was held in New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by Finance Minister Piyush Goyal. It was focused on the concerns and suggestions of the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises. In the meeting, it was decided to create a sub-committee headed by MoS Finance Shiv Pratap Shukla for the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) sector.

Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana Achieves 5 Core Mark

- i. Loksabha Speaker Sumitra Mahajan handed over 5 croreth LPG connection under *Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana* (*PMUY*) to Smt Takrdiran of Delhi in the Parliament House. The 5 crore feat has been achieved in the time period of over 2 years.
- ii. PM Modi launched Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) on 1st May 2016 and it is implemented by Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas through its Oil Marketing Companies. In the current year, considering the huge success of the Scheme, target was revised to 8 crores with budgetary allocation of Rs 12.800 crore.
- **iii.** Uttar Pradesh has got the maximum number of LPG connections (87 lakh) followed by West Bengal (67 lakh) and Bihar (61 lakh).

India Elected President of Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development

- i. AIBD India has been elected as the President of the Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD) for a period of two years. India got elected against Iran during voting which took place at the 44th annual gathering of AIBD in Colombo, Sri Lanka.
- ii. Director General of All India Radio F. Sheheryar was re-elected as chair of the executive board while Sri Lanka was elected as vice-chair. Broadcasters from 26 countries in the region including India are full members of the organization.

Supreme Court To Get 3 Serving Women Judges For 1st Time

i. The Supreme Court will have three serving women judges for the first time, after the Centre cleared the elevation of Madras High Court Chief Justice Indira Banerjee.

ii. The other two judges are **R Banumathi**, appointed in August 2014, and **Indu Malhotra**, appointed in **April 2018**. Notably, SC will have a total of 22 male judges including two new male appointees.

Ballistic Missile Interceptor AAD Successfully Flight Tested

- **i. Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO)** conducted the successful test of the Ballistic Missile Interceptor **Advanced Area Defence (AAD)** from Abdul Kalam Island, Odisha. The endo-atmospheric missile, **capable of intercepting incoming targets at an altitude of 15 to 25 kms** was launched against multiple simulated targets of 1500 km class ballistic missile.
- ii. All the mission objectives were successfully met. Chief of the Air Staff, Air Chief Marshal BS Dhanoa, witnessed the flight test along with other senior officials.

Logo and Tagline For Geographical Indications Launched

- i. Commerce and Industry Minister Suresh Prabhu launched a logo and tagline for Geographical Indications (GI) to increase awareness about intellectual property rights (IPRs) in the country. The slogan for the GI tag is-'Invaluable Treasures of Incredible India'.
- **ii.** A GI product is primarily an agricultural, natural or a manufactured product (handicraft and industrial goods) originating from a definite geographical territory.

World's 1st Hindi-Speaking Robot 'Rashmi'

- i. Ranchi-based software developer Ranjit Srivastava is developing the world's first Hindi-speaking humanoid robot, claimed to cost just Rs50,000 so far.
- **ii.** Named Rashmi, the AI-powered robot can also speak Bhojpuri, Marathi, and English, and is equipped with facial expressions and recognition systems. He was inspired to create Rashmi after seeing Hong Kongmade humanoid 'Sophia' in 2016.

Fortune 500 List of World's Largest Companies Released

- i. Seven Indian companies have been listed in Fortune's 500 list 2018 of world biggest corporations. Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) is the highest ranked company from India followed by RIL which jumped 55 places. The US-based retail company, Walmart has topped the list.
- ii. IOC ranked 137th in 2018 with a significant jump from 168th position from 2017. RIL is the top private sector company in India. It ranked 148th in 2018 from 203rd from 2017. ONGC ranked 197th in 2018 which not even featured in 2017. SBI got 216th rank 1 place higher than 217th in 2017.
- iii. The Top 3 companies on the list are:

- 2. State Grid (China),
- **3.** Sinopec Group (China).

Rajasthan 1st State to Implement Biofuel Policy

- **i.** Rajasthan has become the first State in the country to implement the national policy on biofuels unveiled by the Centre this year. The desert State will lay emphasis on increasing production of oilseeds and establish a Centre for Excellence in Udaipur to promote research in the fields of alternative fuels and energy resources.
- **ii.** The policy on biofuels seeks to help farmers dispose of their surplus stock in an economic manner and reduce the country's oil import dependence.

- i. Google has launched a new video-based Q&A app called 'Cameos' on the App Store, which allows people to answer questions about themselves, then share those answers directly on Google.
- ii. The app is aimed at celebrities and other public figures, who are often the subject of people's Google searches.

ii. he decision to include Khangchendzonga Biosphere Reserve in WNBR was taken at the 30th Session of International Coordinating Council (ICC) of Man and Biosphere (MAB) Programme of UNESCO held at Palembang, Indonesia.

Parliament Passes Bill To Grant Constitutional Status To NCBC

i. The 123rd Constitutional Amendment Bill giving constitutional status to the *National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC)* has got Parliamentary assent. It will give the institution all powers to safeguard the rights of the socially and educationally backward classes and fulfils a long pending commitment of the central govt to the OBCs.

ii. 123rd Constitutional Amendment Bill Explained:

- 1. It seeks to establish the NCBC under the constitution with authority to examine complaints and welfare measures regarding OBCs,
- **2.** NCBC will have a Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and 3 other members of which at least one will be a woman,
- **3.** NCBC will work as an autonomous institution with powers of a civil court.

India To Launch 2nd Lunar Mission 'Chandrayaan-2' on January 3, 2019

- **i.** India will launch its second lunar mission "Chandrayaan-2" on January 3, 2019, to land on the moon with a lander and rover. According to Indian Space Research Organisation Chairman K. Sivan, ISRO is aiming to launch the mission but the window to land on the lunar surface is open till March 2019.
- **ii.** The **800-crore rupees** is the cost of lunar mission named "Chandrayaan-2". The 3,890-kg Chandrayaan-2, which will be launched onboard the **Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mk-3**, will orbit around the moon and study its lunar conditions to collect data on its topography, mineralogy and exosphere.

All You Need To Know About The 'Parker Solar Probe'

- i. NASA's 'Parker Solar Probe' has become the first-ever mission to "touch" the Sun. The spacecraft, about the size of a small car, will travel directly into the Sun's atmosphere about 4 million miles from the surface.
- ii. Parker Solar Probe launched aboard a **Delta IV-Heavy rocket** from Cape Canaveral, the USA.

- **ii.** The team will be deployed during the Independence Day celebrations. The elite women commandos, hailing from the north-eastern states, will be deployed at strategic locations for securing the Independence Day celebrations.

- **i.** The Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) released the Global Liveability Index 2018, the ranking of 140 global cities based on their living conditions. The EIU is part of UK magazine 'The Economist' and provides forecasting and advisory services through research and analysis.
- **ii. Delhi was ranked at 112th position and Mumbai fetched 117th spot.** Austria's capital Vienna has been ranked as the world's most liveable city, displacing Australian city of Melbourne.

NOTA Option Not Applicable For Rajya Sabha Elections: Supreme Court

- i. The Supreme Court ruled that the 'None of The Above' (NOTA) option will not be applicable for voting in the Rajya Sabha elections. The ruling was made by a bench of Justices comprising CJI Dipak Misra and Justices AM Khanwilkar and DY Chandrachud.
- ii. The bench held that the NOTA option is meant only for universal adult suffrage and direct elections and

not for the polls held by the system of proportional representation by means of the single transferable vote as done in the Rajya Sabha.

Chhattisgarh Announces Renaming Of Naya Raipur To Atal Nagar

i. In a tribute to the late former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee, the **Chhattisgarh Cabinet approved the proposal to rename Naya Raipur as 'Atal Nagar'.** Chief Minister Raman Singh made the announcement after a Cabinet meeting.

ii. The Bilaspur University will be known as Atal Bihari Vajpayee University while the Narrow Gauge Line will be called Atal Path. The Central Park, which is being constructed beside collectorate, will be named as Atal Park.

RIL 1st Indian Company To Cross Rs 8 Trillion Market Capital

- i. The Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) became the first Indian company to cross Rs 8 trillion market capitalization after its shares surged nearly 37% in 2018.
- ii. RIL share prices rose 1.31% to hit a record high of Ra1,262.50, pegging its market cap at Rs8.01 trillion after data from the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) showed Reliance Jio continued to add subscribers at a healthy pace.

India's Largest Business Incubator Bhamashah Techno Hub Launched In Jaipur

- i. In a big step forward to strengthen the startup ecosystem in Rajasthan, the Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje launched India's largest business incubator *the Bhamashah Techno Hub* in Jaipur.

- **i.** The U-20 Japan Women's National Team won against the U-20 Spain Women's National Team at the final of the FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup France 2018, taking down the FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup title for the first time in Japanese football history.
- ii. Takarada Saori was named as the Player of the match with her goal and an assist. Takarada was also awarded the Adidas Bronze Boot as well as the Adidas Silver Ball, while Minami was awarded the Bronze Ball.
- **iii.** Japan received the Fair-play award as a team and the FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup France 2018 has closed its curtains.

Tejender Pal Singh Toor Wins Historic Gold in Shot Put

- i. India's Tejinder Pal Singh Toor wins the Gold medal in Men's Shot Put final at the 18th Asian Games in Indonesia. He brought India its seventh gold medal with an Asian Games record throw of 20.75 meters in Jakarta.
- **ii.** Tajinder is the first Indian to win the men's shot put gold at the Asian Games since Bahadur Singh Sagoo, who had thrown a best of 19.03m to win the gold in Busan in 2002. It's the eighth men's shot put gold for India in Asian Games history.

Hima, Anas & Dutee Win Athletics Silvers

- **i. 18-year-old Hima Das won the Silver medal in 400-meter race** in ongoing Asian Games 2018, Indonesia. Hima clocked 50.79 seconds to complete her race.
- **ii. Dutee Chand** also bagged silver medal in women's **100 meter race.** Dutee clocked 11.32 seconds to complete her race. **Muhammed Anas** won Silver medal in **Men's 400m race.** Anas clocked 45.69 seconds to complete his race.

Asian Games 2018: Neeraj Chopra Wins India 1st Javelin Gold in Asiad History

- **i.** Neeraj Chopra became the first-ever Indian javelin thrower to win a gold medal at the Asian Games. The 20-year-old junior world record holder hurled the javelin to a distance of 88.06m to bag the Asiad gold.
- **ii.** Notably, Neeraj had also become the first Indian to bag gold in the javelin throw at the Commonwealth Games earlier this year.

Asian Games 2018: PV Sindhu Wins India's 1st Asian Games Silver In Badminton

- i. World number three PV Sindhu lost to world number one Tai Tzu-ying (Taiwan) in the women's singles final to bag India's first-ever silver medal in badminton at Asian Games.
- ii. Sindhu, playing in her fifth final of 2018, lost the match with a scoreline of 13-21, 16-21.

Asian Games 2018: Manjit Singh Wins Gold In 800m Race

- i. India's 28-year-old sprinter Manjit Singh won the gold medal in the men's 800m event at the 2018 Asian Games, securing the ninth gold for the country.
- ii. Another Indian sprinter Jinson Johnson, who is ranked first in Asia, won the silver at the event. Meanwhile, Dutee Chand secured herself a place in the women's 200m finals, while Hima Das was disqualified.

Arpinder Singh Wins Gold In Triple Jump

- **i. Arpinder Singh** ended India's 48-year long wait for **a gold in triple jump at the Asian Games** with an effort of **16.77m**. India's last Asian Games gold medal in men's triple jump had come in 1970 from Mohinder Singh Gill.
- ii. Arpinder, who has been without a medal in multi-sporting events since winning a bronze in the **2014 Commonwealth Games,** produced his best jump of 16.77m in his third attempt.

Swapna Barman, 1st Indian Heptathlete To Win Gold In Asian Games


- i. Swapna Barman created history by becoming the first Indian heptathlete to win an Asian Games gold in Indonesia, a feat she achieved despite a toothache.
- **ii.** The 21-year-old Barman logged 6026 points from the seven events competed for two days. En route to the title, she won the high jump (1003 points) and javelin throw (872 points) events and finished second-best in shot put (707 points) and long jump (865 points).

Women's 4x400m Relay Team Wins Gold

- i. India won gold in the women's 4X400 metre event.
- ii. The Indian quartet of **Hima Das, Raju Poovamma, Saritaben Laxmanbhai Gayakwad and Vismaya Koroth** registered a time of 3 minutes and 28.72 seconds to finish at the top of the podium. India clinched the silver medal in the men's 4X400 metre event.

Asian Games 2018: Jinson Johnson Wins Gold in Men's 1500m Event

- i. India's Jinson Johnson claimed the gold medal in the men's 1500m event in the Asian Games 2018 in Jakarta, Indonesia. Manjit Singh, 800m champion, however, finished fourth.
- **ii.** Johnson clocked 3:44.72 sec to claim the top honours ahead of Iran's Amir Moradi, who turned in a timing of 3:45.62sec, his season's best effort. Johnson earlier won a silver in the 800m event.



Obituaries

Australian Professional Golfer Jarrod Lyle Passes Away

- i. Australian professional golfer Jarrod Lyle has died after a long battle with cancer, aged 36.
- **ii.** The Australian won twice on the feeder Web.com tour in 2008 and played 121 US PGA Tour tournaments during his professional career.

DMK Chief M Karunanidhi Passes Away

- i. Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) chief and former Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M. Karunanidhi passed away in Chennai. He was the 94-year-old veteran leader of Tamil Nadu.
- ii. He started as a screenwriter in Tamil film industry and was Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu for five-term.

Legendary India Captain Ajit Wadekar Passes Away At 77

- **i.** Former India cricket captain Ajit Wadekar, who led the team to path-breaking Test wins in England and the West Indies, passed away after prolonged illness. He was 77.
- **ii.** The aggressive batsman was a trailblazer in Indian cricket despite a mere 37 Test appearances, leading India to triumphs in England and the West Indies in 1971. Wadekar scored 2,113 runs in his Test career, including one hundred, and was also the country's first ODI captain.

Former PM Atal Bihari Vajpayee has passes Away

- **i.** Former prime minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee has passed away aged 93 in Delhi. Atal Bihari Vajpayee was three times Prime Minister of India. First Term: May 1996, Second Term: 1998-1999 and Third Term: 1999-2004.
- **ii.** A member of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Vajpayee served as the eleventh Prime Minister of India. He headed the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance in the Indian Parliament, and became the first Prime Minister unaffiliated with the Indian National Congress to complete a full five-year term in office.

Chhattisgarh Governor Balramji Das Tandon Passes Away

- i. Chhattisgarh Governor Balramji Das Tandon passed away at the age of 90.
- ii. He was admitted to a hospital in Raipur after he suffered cardiac arrest.

Former Lok Sabha Speaker Somnath Chatterjee Passes Away

- i. Former Lok Sabha speaker Somnath Chatterjee passed away. He was 89 years old.
- **ii.** Chatterjee was the Speaker of the Lower House from 2004-09 when Manmohan Singh-led UPA- 1 (United Progressive Alliance) was in power.

Former UN chief and Nobel laureate Kofi Annan Passes Away

- i. Former United Nations Secretary-General Kofi Annan has passed away at the age of 80. Annan, who was the seventh Secretary-General of the United Nations, served at the UN from 1997 to 2006.
- ii. Annan was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize along with the **UN in 2001** "for their work for a better organized and more peaceful world".

VS Naipaul: Nobel Prize Winner Dies At 85

- i. Nobel Prize-winning British author V S Naipaul has died at the age of 85.
- ii. Vidiadhar Surajprasad Naipaul who was born in Trinidad wrote more than 30 books and won the Nobel Literature Prize in 2001.

US Singer Aretha Franklin Passes Away at 76



- **i.** US Senator John McCain, a celebrated Vietnam war hero, passed away after losing a battle to brain cancer. He was 81. The six-term senator, McCain was also a Republican presidential nominee in 2008.
- **ii.** A fighter pilot during the Vietnam War, he spent more than five years as a prisoner of war after his plane was shot down.
