## Assam, 1st State To Launch Wage Compensation Scheme For Pregnant Women In Tea Gardens

- i. Assam Government has become the first Indian state to offer a Wage Compensation Scheme for pregnant women working in the tea gardens of the state. The scheme will be launched by Assam Chief Minister Sarbanand Sonowal in Guwahati. The announcement was made by the state's Health and Finance Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma.
- **ii.** Under the scheme, **an amount of Rs 12,000** will be given to the pregnant women so that they can take care of themselves and the unborn baby. The compensation of wages to pregnant women will be given in 4 instalments Rs 2,000 in the first trimester, Rs 4,000 in the second trimester, Rs 3,000 for institutional delivery and Rs 3,000 for registration of the child's birth.

- i. Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) launched a Flood Forecasting and Early Warning System (FFEWS) for Kolkata City. It is also India's first comprehensive city-level FFEWS. It will reduce economic loss and impacts on livelihood and improve flood awareness and safety at the community level.
- ii. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) funded the design and implementation of the FFEWS through a \$1 million technical assistance to KMC from its Urban Climate Change Resilience Trust Fund under the Urban Financing Partnership Facility.

- **ii.** Out of 157 countries measured, **Denmark topped the list** based on its high and progressive taxation, high social spending and good protection of workers. Ranking at 11th, **Japan became the topper among the Asian countries.** Among the BRICS nations, China was ranked 81st on the list, Brazil 39th and Russia 50th.

## Cabinet Approves Merger of NCVT And NSDA To Establish NCVET

- i. The Union Cabinet has approved the merger of the existing regulatory institutions in the skills space National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) and the National Skill Development Agency (NSDA) into the National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET).
- **ii.** NCVET will regulate the functioning of entities engaged in vocational education and training, both long-term and short-term and establish minimum standards for the functioning of such entities. **iii.** The primary functions of NCVET will include -
  - recognition and regulation of awarding bodies, assessment bodies and skill related information providers;
  - approval of qualifications developed by awarding bodies and Sector Skill Councils (SSCs);
  - indirect regulation of vocational training institutes through awarding bodies and assessment agencies;

- research and information dissemination;
- grievance redressal.

- i. A Chinese company has tested the 'world's largest' cargo drone Feihong-98 (FH-98) which can carry a payload of 1.5 tonnes (1,500kg).

- i. Sixteen-year-old shooter Manu Bhaker has become the first-ever Indian woman to win gold at Youth Olympics.

- **ii.** Under the deal, Alvarez will participate in 11 fights, starting December 15, 2018. The previous richest contract was the 13-year, \$325-million deal signed by New York Yankees' Giancarlo Stanton in 2014.

#### Souray Kothari Clinches World Billiards Championship

- i. India's Sourav Kothari defeated Peter Gilchrist of Singapore 1134-944 to clinch the 2018 WBL World Billiards Championship title.
- **ii.** The former national and Asian Billiards champion had missed out on winning the coveted World Billiards crown on two occasions in the last two years, including a loss to **Gilchrist** in 2016 final in **Bengaluru**.

## Roger Federer Won 99th Career Title In His Hometown

- i. Swiss tennis star Roger Federer won his 99th career title after winning the Basel Open for the ninth time in his career.

## **International Day of Older Persons: 1 October**

**i. The International Day of Older Persons** is observed on October 1 each year to recognize the contributions of older persons and to examine issues that affect their lives. **ii.** The theme for the 2018 celebration is "Celebrating Older Human Rights champions".

#### World Animal Day: 4 October

- **i.** World Animal Day is celebrated at various parts of the world on 4th October to raise the status of animals in order to improve welfare standards around the globe.
- **ii.** World Animal Day was originated by Heinrich Zimmermann. He organized the first World Animal Day on 24 March 1925 at the Sports Palace in Berlin, Germany.

i. World Teachers' Day is celebrated globally on 5th October. The WTD 2018 will mark the 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948) that recognizes education as a key fundamental right and establishes an entitlement to free compulsory education, ensuring inclusive and equitable access for all children.

ii. The theme for this year's WTD is "The right to education means the right to a qualified teacher".
